

# Initial Guide for CSiS students



## What about ZIM account: <a href="https://zim.uni-wuppertal.de/de/hilfe/benutzerberatung/">https://zim.uni-wuppertal.de/de/hilfe/benutzerberatung/</a>

The ZIM department is the university's IT user support department. With your matriculation documents you have received a letter with your ZIM account information and a password. Activate your ZIM account ASAP. This is initial to set up your university Email address and to access StudiLöwe and Moodle.

# What about StudiLöwe: https://studiloewe.uni-wuppertal.de

StudiLöwe is the official course directory. To get information about courses, select "Studienangebot" in the menu on the left. Under "Vorlesungsverzeichnis anzeigen" all courses of the CSiS study program are listed. To find a specific course you can also use the function "Veranstaltungen suchen" in the menu.

#### What about MOODLE: https://moodle.uni-wuppertal.de

Moodle is an online platform where you can find study rooms for single courses as well as project or exercise courses. The login for Moodle requires a ZIM account. IMPORTANT: For most of your courses you have to register through Moodle. Through Moodle, your lecturers and tutors inform you about latest updates on the classes, exam dates or any course relevant information.

## How to find a MOODLE course:

You find the relevant Moodle links on the -> <u>StudiLöwe</u> portal under the corresponding course if you got to "Grunddaten".

#### Which courses do I have to attend in the (first) semester?

Bundled, up-to-date information is available on the CSiS timetable, the module reference book and the CSiS examination regulations available on the CSiS website. Another source of information is the course directory at StudiLöwe.
